The Mayo Clinic 28th Audiology Conference is a live interactive conference via webcast targeted to audiologists, audiology students, otorhinolaryngologists, and others involved in hearing health care and dizziness/balance. The morning session will focus on balance dysfunction in children as well as noise-induced hearing. The afternoon segment will include a humanitarian effort in the Dominican Republic and over-the-counter hearing aids.

At the conclusion of the Mayo Clinic 28th Audiology Conference participants should be able to:

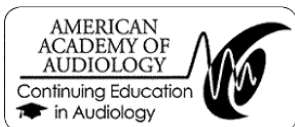
- Describe signs of vestibular dysfunction in children.
